

tmux cheatsheet

Prefix = Ctrl-b. "C-b d" = press Ctrl-b, release, then d.

Survive a dropped SSH connection

```
tmux new -s work      # start named session
# run your long job inside
# C-b d  -> detach (job keeps running)

tmux attach -t work    # reattach later
tmux attach -d -t work # force-attach
```

Sessions

New named session	tmux new -s NAME
List sessions	tmux ls
Attach	tmux attach -t NAME
Force attach (kick stale)	tmux attach -d -t NAME
Detach (from inside)	C-b d
Rename session	C-b \$
Kill one session	tmux kill-session -t NAME
Kill server (all)	tmux kill-server
Switch session	C-b s

Windows (tabs)

New window	C-b c
Next / previous	C-b n / C-b p
Go to window N	C-b 0...9
Rename window	C-b ,
Close window	C-b & / exit
List / pick window	C-b w

Panes (splits)

Split left/right	C-b %
Split top/bottom	C-b "
Move between panes	C-b + arrows
Cycle panes	C-b o
Zoom toggle (fullscreen)	C-b z
Close pane	C-b x / exit
Pane -> window	C-b !

Scrolling & copy mode

Enter copy/scroll mode	C-b [
Scroll	arrows / PgUp / PgDn
Search up / down	? / /
Quit copy mode	q

Handy

Command prompt	C-b :
List all bindings	C-b ?
Reload config	C-b : source-file ~/.tmux.conf

Watch a long job

```
tail -f export-mainnet-*.log
# Ctrl-c stops tailing; job keeps running
```

Minimal ~/.tmux.conf

```
set -g history-limit 100000 # scrollbar
set -g mouse on             # mouse
setw -g mode-keys vi        # vi copy
```
